PROCEDURE

1. Permit filled out by owner or owner's representative
2. Driveway to be physically located and monumented (staked) in the field for preliminary inspection by county personnel. County will determine exact location of culvert, size required, and any drainage improvements necessary for culvert to function properly.
3. County will complete the permit and return to the applicant along with specifications.
4. Applicant shall complete the work according to the specifications and requirements of Fayette county.
5. Applicant shall contact the engineer's office for a final inspection.
6. When the work is approved, county will release to the building department for an occupancy permit. Occupancy permit will not be released until all work is completed to the satisfaction of the county.

AGREEMENT

I/we agree to the following conditions of this permit:

1. That the owner shall bear **all** costs associated with the construction.
2. That I/we assume the responsibility for, and will save the county harmless from any and all claims for personal injuries and/or property damages, and shall defend any action that might be brought due to the work activities under this permit.
3. That traffic will be maintained at all times (unless specific permission is granted by the county engineer) according to Fayette county standards and the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices. Also that lights, signs, barricades and flag men will be used on the project where required by Fayette county and that the site will be protected from traffic at all times, both day and night.
4. That if the roadway, berms, ditches, or other drainage appurtenances are damaged during construction, the applicant will be responsible for repairs and/or restoration to the satisfaction of the county engineer.
5. That the Ohio Utility Protection Service (OUPS), phone 1-800-362-2764 will be notified 48 hours prior to any excavation or digging.
6. That responsibility under this permit will remain in force until a release has been granted by the Fayette County Engineer's office.
7. **I/we agree to install any necessary mailbox according to County and U.S. Postal service standards and will not construct any brick, stone or other structure inside the right-of-way that could be categorized as a safety hazard or an obstruction. The Engineer's Office reserves the right to remove any non-standard structures.**
8. That two (2) days notice will be given to the engineer's office prior to beginning construction.
