AGREEMENT

I/we agree to the following conditions of this permit:

1. That the owner shall bear **all** costs associated with the construction.
2. That I/we assume the responsibility for, and will save the county/township harmless from any and all claims for personal injuries and/or property damages, and shall defend any and all claims for personal injuries and/or property damages, and shall defend any action that might be brought due to the work activities under this permit.
3. That traffic will be maintained at all times(unless specific permission is granted by the County Engineer) according to Fayette County Standards and the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices. Also that lights, signs, barricades and flag men will be used on the project where required by Fayette County and that the site will be protected from traffic at all times, both day and night.
4. That if roadway, berms, ditches, tiles or other drainage appurtenances are damaged during construction, the applicant will be responsible for repairs and/or restoration to the satisfaction of the County Engineer.
5. That the Ohio Utility Projection Service (OUPS), Phone 1-800-362-2764 will be notified 48 hours prior to any excavation or digging.
6. That no open cutting of any township or county road will be permitted without expressed written consent of the County Engineer.
7. That any excavation shall be done by an approved method of trenching. No "knifing" of any kind will be allowed. All new installations located within ten (10) feet, either side of a culvert under the road must remain open until inspected by the County.
8. That all installations of underground lines will maintain a minimum depth of three (3) feet below grade and where lines are not installed to the minimum depth the owner of the utility will hold the county/township harmless for any damage caused to the line during the performance of their duties.
9. That two (2) days notice will be given to the Engineer's office prior to beginning construction.
